PONY PALS

Children up to age 7 (or until first grade) are introduced to the basics of riding in the Pony Pals program. Weekly, half-hour lessons help children gain confidence, improve balance, increase coordination, and develop self-control. Pony Pals are led on ponies or horses trained for lesson use while developing the fundamentals of riding in preparation for our regular lesson program. Lessons are private or in small groups and we encourage parents to actively participate with their children. The semester calendar and tuition rates (Level I) are the same as the other lessons.

GROUP LESSONS

All students above Hunt Seat Beginner I are in group lessons once they master maneuvering their horse/pony around other horses while in their lesson. The group lesson format is one hour of riding with approximately 15 to 60 minutes of extra time in the barn for taking care of the horse before/after the lesson. Riders in these levels may opt for private lessons if so desired.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are for all beginner students who are not ready to ride in a group lesson format. Privates are also a great way to get ready for a show or to work on a problem. For beginning riders, they are a half hour in riding time with 15 to 30 minutes of care for the horse before/after the lesson. For more advanced riders, they are one hour in length, with half-hour lessons available if space is available in the schedule. We feel that the more advanced riders receive much more out of hour long lessons.

STAYING UPDATED

Remember to check the bulletin boards, website, and your emails for updates on the news of Ace-High. We rely on our electronic methods for getting news to you. If you do not receive emails from us, make sure to update your information with us as we may not have an email or may have the incorrect email for you on file.

Need to make PAYMENTS?

To pay by using payments, you will need to send a check with the registration form for half of the total tuition amount. You will also need to enclose an additional check for the remaining balance of the tuition which needs to be dated for the first day of this session. **If you do this method, then you need to ADD \$20 to the cost of the package above which you are doing.**

PAY BY THE LESSON and TRIAL Lessons

Riders who cannot attend lessons on a regular weekly basis, or who want to take a trail or “brush up” lesson may enroll in the PAY BY THE LESSON (private prices are those listed above for the each price). These lessons MUST be schedule at least FOUR days in advance.

HORSEMANSHIP AND RIDING

Horse grooming, tacking up, trail rides, arena riding, and on occasion, unmounted lessons are all part of the Ace-High Riding Experience.

INTRODUCTORY LESSONS

Introductory lessons are still available as a one time package to first time clients. The six week session half-hour privates lessons are \$105.00 per person for Level I, \$165.00 per person for Level II, and \$225.00 per person for Level III. Please inquire for more details on the Introductory Lesson Program.

ABSENCES

We have a 24 hour cancellation policy. If you cancel 24 hours or more in advance, you are not charged for the lesson. If you cancel 12 to 24 hours in advance you are charged for half of the lesson. If you cancel less than 12 hours in advance, you are charged the full price of the lesson. We are sorry but there are no exceptions to this policy.

As the schedule changes every session, it is necessary to send in a registration each session. Spots are NOT held from session to session. We schedule registrations as they are received. Register early to help ensure your day/time choice. Late registrations and signing up mid-session will only be accepted if there is space available at that level for that session. Ace-High has the RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY STUDENT'S APPLICATION for ANY REASON. The staff tries to schedule each student for the first choice of day/time requested, but PLEASE list a second and third choice in case your first choice is not available. The schedule for the session will be posted on line at www.acehigh.info under the calendar section about one week prior to the session starting. Please check the site or the bulletin board at the farm to verify lesson times/instructors.

MAKE UP/BONUS LESSON

With our new system an extra week of lessons from September 7th to 13th as a make up for those who have missed lessons or BONUS lesson for those who have not missed any lessons. ALL students should plan to attend this week! No other make up lessons will be arranged. The extra lesson is provided at no additional cost (pay by the lesson is excluded) and will be held at the regular lesson time.

Each fully completed registration with payment that is received in the office by the due date will be eligible for the drawing for a free private lesson (half-hour).

PROPER RIDING ATTIRE

ALL students enrolled in ANY Ace-High riding program must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet if jumping, riding in the open, or under the age of 18. All riders over 18 riding on the flat in an arena may sign a waiver to refuse a helmet. Long, ankle length pants/jeans and boots with 1/2” to 1” heel must be worn. No baggy or loose fitting clothes allowed.
